

Designed to empower leaders and sustain on-going Leadership, this one-day advanced workshop provides an annual reunion, refresher, and recommitment for all alumni of the Anderson Center's Leadership Forum. The workshop will focus on:



LQ2: Assess your progress. Participants will have the option to complete, analyze and review the Leadership Quotient (a second round of FranklinCovey's online 360-degree assessment). This feedback process provides valuable data to help participants measure their own leadership capacity and capability, compare it to LQ1 results and further develop their own action plans.



4 IMPERATIVES OF GREAT LEADERS: Review the the 4 Imperatives. Leadership teams will enhance their understanding through a comprehensive review of each imperative to further individual and organizational development goals.



UNLEASH TALENT: Take a deeper dive into Unleashing Talent, one of the 4 Imperatives. Apply your knowledge to an actual leadership situation. Participants will be able to examine, explore, and discuss the challenges of leadership through group discussion. The workshop also includes action planning, implementation strategies, discussion and networking.
