## FORUM OBJECTIVES



Before the forum begins, leaders will participate in FranklinCovey's online 360-degree Leadership Quotient® (LQ) assessment. This feedback process provides valuable data to help participants measure their own leadership capacity and capability and will be utilized throughout the Forum.



During the 3 day forum, participants will be oriented to the 4 Imperatives of Great Leaders so they will be able to effectively 1) Inspire Trust, 2) Clarify Purpose, 3) Align Systems, and 4) Unleash Talent. An action plan for development and improvement will be created.



Online resources ([www.leadershipcontract.com](http://www.leadershipcontract.com)) and various follow-up activities, including the opportunity for another assessment to measure improvements after six months (LQ<sub>2</sub>), will support ongoing development.
