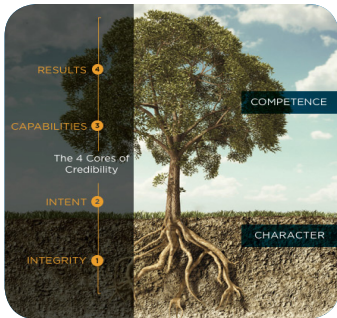




## ANDERSON CENTER MANAGEMENT AND LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT
